Pope Francis in *Let Us Dream* (2020) said, "In the trials of life, you reveal your own heart: how solid it is, how merciful, how big or small."

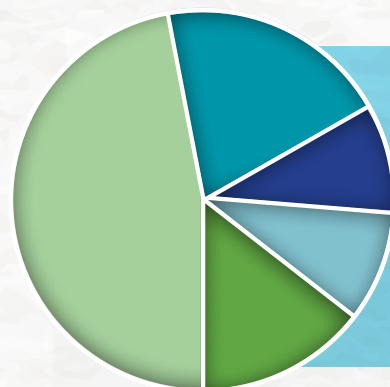
